A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Maryland After-School Opportunity Act - Appropriation - Requirements**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Governor to include an appropriation of a certain
4 amount for a certain fiscal year for the Maryland After-School Opportunity
5 Fund; providing that a certain amount of the total appropriation shall be subject
6 to certain matching fund requirements; prohibiting disbursements that exceed a
7 certain amount to recipients; and generally relating to the Maryland
8 After-School Opportunity Act.

9 BY adding to
10 Article 41 - Governor - Executive and Administrative Departments
11 Section 6-808

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article 41 - Governor - Executive and Administrative Departments**

17 6-808.

18 (A) THE GOVERNOR SHALL INCLUDE AN APPROPRIATION OF NOT LESS THAN
19 \$20 MILLION IN THE STATE BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2003 FOR THE MARYLAND
20 AFTER-SCHOOL OPPORTUNITY FUND.

21 (B) THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE SHALL DISBURSE \$10 MILLION OF THE
22 AMOUNT APPROPRIATED TO THE FUND FOR FISCAL YEAR 2003 IN ACCORDANCE WITH
23 THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBTITLE.

24 (C) (1) TEN MILLION DOLLARS OF THE AMOUNT APPROPRIATED TO THE
25 FUND FOR FISCAL YEAR 2003 SHALL BE DISBURSED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE

1 PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBTITLE AND SUBJECT TO THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS
2 SUBSECTION.

3 (2) EACH RECIPIENT OF FUNDS UNDER THIS SUBSECTION SHALL
4 PROVIDE AND EXPEND A MATCHING FUND EQUAL TO THE AMOUNT OF FUNDS THAT
5 THE RECIPIENT IS AWARDED.

6 (3) THE TOTAL GRANTS AWARDED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION TO ALL
7 THE RECIPIENTS IN ANY COUNTY, INCLUDING BALTIMORE CITY, MAY NOT EXCEED
8 \$2,500,000.

9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
10 effect October 1, 2001.
