## 2 Correctional Services - Inmates - Indecent Exposure

- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 18 (A) WORDS OR PHRASES IN THIS SECTION THAT DESCRIBE THE
- 19 COMMON-LAW CRIME OF INDECENT EXPOSURE SHALL RETAIN THEIR JUDICIALLY
- 20 DETERMINED MEANINGS EXCEPT TO THE EXTENT EXPRESSLY OR IMPLICITLY
- 21 CHANGED IN THIS SECTION.
- 22 (B) AN INMATE MAY NOT WILLFULLY AND INTENTIONALLY EXPOSE PRIVATE
- 23 PARTS OF THE INMATE'S BODY IN THE PRESENCE OF A MEMBER OF THE OPPOSITE
- 24 SEX.
- 25 (C) AN INMATE WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR
- 26 AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 3 YEARS OR A
- 27 FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$1,000 OR BOTH.

- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 2 October 1, 2001.
