1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Correctional Services - Inmates - Indecent Exposure**

3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting an inmate from willfully and intentionally exposing
4 certain parts of the inmate's body to a member of the opposite sex; providing
5 that certain words and phrases retain their judicially determined meaning;
6 providing a certain penalty be imposed against an inmate convicted of exposing
7 certain parts of the inmate's body to a member of the opposite sex; and generally
8 relating to inmates and indecent exposure.

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article - Correctional Services**

17 8-803.

18 (A) WORDS OR PHRASES IN THIS SECTION THAT DESCRIBE THE
19 COMMON-LAW CRIME OF INDECENT EXPOSURE SHALL RETAIN THEIR JUDICIALLY
20 DETERMINED MEANINGS EXCEPT TO THE EXTENT EXPRESSLY OR IMPLICITLY
21 CHANGED IN THIS SECTION.

1 (B) AN INMATE MAY NOT WILLFULLY AND INTENTIONALLY EXPOSE PRIVATE
2 PARTS OF THE INMATE'S BODY IN THE PRESENCE OF A MEMBER OF THE OPPOSITE
3 SEX.

4 (C) AN INMATE WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR
5 AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 3 YEARS OR A
6 FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$1,000 OR BOTH.

7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
8 October 1, 2001.
