3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting an inmate from willfully and intentionally exposing

1 (B) AN INMATE MAY NOT WILLFULLY AND INTENTIONALLY EXPOSE PRIVATE 2 PARTS OF THE INMATE'S BODY IN THE PRESENCE OF A MEMBER OF THE OPPOSITE 3 SEX.

4 (C) AN INMATE WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR 5 AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 3 YEARS OR A 6 FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$1,000 OR BOTH.

7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 8 October 1, 2001.
