18 If excess lottery revenues from the prior fiscal year do not provide funds in [(c) 19 an amount sufficient to fully credit the Special Fund as required under this section, 20 the Governor may request a deficiency appropriation during the next legislative 21 session.]

22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency 23 measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, 24 has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members 25 elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from 26 the date it is enacted. It shall remain effective through June 30, 2003 2002, and, at 27 the end of June 30, 2003 2002, with no further action required by the General

28 Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.

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
