18	(b) (10) (i) On or before July 1, 2000, the Commission shall issue orders or adopt regulations reasonably designed to ensure the creation of competitive electricity supply and electricity supply services markets, with appropriate customer safeguards.

	1. an appropriate code of conduct between the electric company and an affiliate providing electricity supply and electricity supply services in the State;
