SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 12

Except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, a voting 16 (f) (1)system authorized by law before July 1, 1978, including the use of paper ballots, shall 17 18 be deemed certified.

19 On or after January 1, [2002] 2004, a voting system that uses (2)20 mechanical lever machines may not be deemed certified.

21 9-103.

Except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, a voting 22 (d) (1)23 system that is deemed certified under § 9-102(f) of this subtitle may not be 24 decertified by the State Board.

25 (2)On January 1, [2002] 2004, the State Board shall decertify a 26 mechanical lever voting machine.

2 (a) On or after January 1, [2002] 2004, a county may not use mechanical lever 3 voting machines to conduct elections.

4 (b) Until January 1, [2002] 2004, if a county uses mechanical lever voting 5 machines to conduct elections, the members of the local board:

6 (1) Shall appoint a voting machine custodian and a deputy custodian; 7 and

8 (2) May employ additional deputy custodians.

9 (c) The voting machine custodian and deputy custodians shall have the duties,

10 and complete any training program, specified in regulations adopted by the State11 Board.
