A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Baltimore City - Local Government Tort Claims Act - Baltimore Public**
3 **Markets Corporation**

4 FOR the purpose of providing that Baltimore Public Markets Corporation, in
5 Baltimore City, meets the definition of local government for the purposes of the
6 Local Government Tort Claims Act; providing that Baltimore Public Markets
7 Corporation, in Baltimore City, may not raise a certain defense; providing for
8 the application of this Act; and generally relating to the Local Government Tort
9 Claims Act and Baltimore City Public Markets Corporation, in Baltimore City.

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings**

18 5-301.

19 (d) "Local government" means:

20 (1) A chartered county established under Article 25A of the Code;

21 (2) A code county established under Article 25B of the Code;

22 (3) A board of county commissioners established or operating under
23 Article 25 of the Code;

24 (4) Baltimore City;

25 (5) A municipal corporation established or operating under Article 23A of
26 the Code;

- 1 (6) The Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission;
- 2 (7) The Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission;
- 3 (8) The Northeast Maryland Waste Disposal Authority;
- 4 (9) A community college or board of trustees for a community college
5 established or operating under Title 16 of the Education Article, not including
6 Baltimore City Community College;
- 7 (10) A county public library or board of trustees of a county public library
8 established or operating under Title 23, Subtitle 4 of the Education Article;
- 9 (11) The Enoch Pratt Free Library or Board of Trustees of the Enoch Pratt
10 Free Library;
- 11 (12) The Washington County Free Library or the Board of Trustees of the
12 Washington County Free Library;
- 13 (13) A special taxing district;
- 14 (14) A nonprofit community service corporation incorporated under State
15 law that is authorized to collect charges or assessments;
- 16 (15) Housing authorities created under Article 44A of the Code;
- 17 (16) A sanitary district, sanitary commission, metropolitan commission,
18 or other sewer or water authority established or operating under public local law or
19 public general law;
- 20 (17) The Baltimore Metropolitan Council;
- 21 (18) The Howard County Economic Development Authority;
- 22 (19) The Howard County Mental Health Authority;
- 23 (20) A commercial district management authority established by a county
24 or municipal corporation if provided under local law;
- 25 (21) The Baltimore City Police Department;
- 26 (22) A regional library resource center or a cooperative library corporation
27 established under Title 23, Subtitle 2 of the Education Article; [and]
- 28 (23) Lexington Market, Inc., in Baltimore City; AND
- 29 (24) BALTIMORE PUBLIC MARKETS CORPORATION, IN BALTIMORE CITY.

2 (f) (1) Lexington Market, Inc., in Baltimore City, and its employees, may
3 not raise as a defense a limitation on liability described under § 5-406 of this title.

4 (2) BALTIMORE PUBLIC MARKETS CORPORATION, IN BALTIMORE CITY,
5 AND ITS EMPLOYEES, MAY NOT RAISE AS A DEFENSE A LIMITATION ON LIABILITY
6 DESCRIBED UNDER § 5-406 OF THIS TITLE.

7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be
8 construed only prospectively and may not be applied or interpreted to have any effect
9 on or application to any cause of action arising before the effective date of this Act.

10 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
11 October 1, 2001.
