## 1 AN ACT concerning

## 2 Creation of a State Debt - Calvert County - Chesapeake Beach Railway Trail

- 3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt in the amount of
- 4 \$300,000 \( \frac{\$250,000}{}, \) the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Mayor and Town
- 5 Council of the Town of Chesapeake Beach for certain development or
- 6 improvement purposes; providing for disbursement of the loan proceeds; and
- 7 providing generally for the issuance and sale of bonds evidencing the loan.

## 8 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

- 9 MARYLAND, That:
- 10 (1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on
- 11 behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Calvert
- 12 County Chesapeake Beach Railway Trail Loan of 2001 in a total principal amount of
- 13 \$300,000 \$250,000. This loan shall be evidenced by the issuance, sale, and delivery of
- 14 State general obligation bonds authorized by a resolution of the Board of Public
- 15 Works and issued, sold, and delivered in accordance with §§ 8-117 through 8-124 of
- 16 the State Finance and Procurement Article and Article 31, § 22 of the Code.
- 17 (2) The bonds to evidence this loan or installments of this loan may be sold as
- 18 a single issue or may be consolidated and sold as part of a single issue of bonds under
- 19 § 8-122 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.
- 20 (3) The cash proceeds of the sale of the bonds shall be paid to the Treasurer
- 21 and first shall be applied to the payment of the expenses of issuing, selling, and
- 22 delivering the bonds, unless funds for this purpose are otherwise provided, and then
- 23 shall be credited on the books of the Comptroller and expended, on approval by the
- 24 Board of Public Works, for the following public purposes, including any applicable

- 1 architects' and engineers' fees: as a grant to the Mayor and Town Council of the Town
- 2 of Chesapeake Beach (referred to hereafter in this Act as "the grantee") for the
- 3 planning, design, and construction of facilities for the Chesapeake Beach Railway
- 4 Trail, a recreational trail that will include paved trails, timber walkways, and
- 5 bridges.
- 6 (4) An annual State tax is imposed on all assessable property in the State in
- 7 rate and amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds, as and
- 8 when due and until paid in full. The principal shall be discharged within 15 years
- 9 after the date of issuance of the bonds.
- 10 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 11 June 1, 2001.
