CHAPTER	
1 AN ACT concerning	
2 Creation of a State Debt - Prince George's County - Penn Forest Shopping Multiplex Recreational and Community Development Center	
4 FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt in the amount of \$700,000 not to exceed \$300,000 \$140,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Board of Directors of The Believers Worship Center, Inc. for certain development or improvement purposes; prohibiting the use of the proceeds of the sale of the bonds and the matching fund for sectarian religious purposes; providing for disbursement of the loan proceeds, subject to a requirement that the grantee provide and expend a matching fund; and providing generally for the issuance and sale of bonds evidencing the loan.	
12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 13 MARYLAND, That:	
14 (1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on 15 behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Prince 16 George's County - Penn Forest Shopping Center Multiplex Recreational and	

- 1 Community Development Center Loan of 2001 in the a total principal amount of
- 2 \$700,000 equal to the lesser of (i) \$300,000 \$140,000 or (ii) the amount of the
- 3 matching fund provided in accordance with Section 1(5) below. This loan shall be
- 4 evidenced by the issuance, sale, and delivery of State general obligation bonds
- 5 authorized by a resolution of the Board of Public Works and issued, sold, and
- 6 delivered in accordance with §§ 8-117 through 8-124 of the State Finance and
- 7 Procurement Article and Article 31, § 22 of the Code.
- 8 (2) The bonds to evidence this loan or installments of this loan may be sold as 9 a single issue or may be consolidated and sold as part of a single issue of bonds under 10 § 8-122 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.
- 11 (3) The cash proceeds of the sale of the bonds shall be paid to the Treasurer
- 12 and first shall be applied to the payment of the expenses of issuing, selling, and
- 13 delivering the bonds, unless funds for this purpose are otherwise provided, and then
- 14 shall be credited on the books of the Comptroller and expended, on approval by the
- 15 Board of Public Works, for the following public purposes, including any applicable
- 16 architects' and engineers' fees: as a grant to the Board of Directors of The Believers
- 17 Worship Center, Inc. (referred to hereafter in this Act as "the grantee") for the
- 18 planning, design, construction, repair, renovation, reconstruction, and capital
- 19 equipping of a retail shopping center facility located in Forestville Capitol Heights,
- 20 Maryland to be used as a recreational and community development center.
- 21 (4) An annual State tax is imposed on all assessable property in the State in
- 22 rate and amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds, as and
- 23 when due and until paid in full. The principal shall be discharged within 15 years
- 24 after the date of issuance of the bonds.
- 25 (5) Prior to the payment of any funds under the provisions of this Act for the
- 26 purposes set forth in Section 1(3) above, the grantee shall provide and expend a
- 27 matching fund of \$450,000. No part of the grantee's matching fund may be provided,
- 28 either directly or indirectly, from funds of the State, whether appropriated or
- 29 unappropriated. No part of the fund may consist of real property or in kind
- 30 contributions. The fund may consist of funds expended prior to the effective date of
- 31 this Act. In case of any dispute as to the amount of the matching fund or what money
- 32 or assets may qualify as matching funds, the Board of Public Works shall determine
- 33 the matter and the Board's decision is final. The grantee has until June 1, 2003, to
- 34 present evidence satisfactory to the Board of Public Works that a matching fund will
- 35 be provided. If satisfactory evidence is presented, the Board shall certify this fact and
- 36 the amount of the matching fund to the State Treasurer, and the proceeds of the loan
- 37 <u>equal to the amount of the matching fund</u> shall be expended for the purposes provided
- 38 in this Act. Any amount of the loan in excess of the amount of the matching fund
- 39 certified by the Board of Public Works shall be canceled and be of no further effect.
- 40 (6) No portion of the proceeds of the loan or any of the matching funds may be
- 41 used for the furtherance of sectarian religious instruction, or in connection with the
- 42 design, acquisition, or construction of any building used or to be used as a place of
- 43 sectarian religious worship or instruction, or in connection with any program or
- 44 department of divinity for any religious denomination. Upon the request of the Board

- 1 of Public Works, the grantee shall submit evidence satisfactory to the Board that none 2 of the proceeds of the loan or any matching funds have been or are being used for a
- 3 purpose prohibited by this Act.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 5 June 1, 2001.
