## A BILL ENTITLED

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## 2 State Department of Education - Professional Assistants

- 3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the appointment of an additional Deputy State
- 4 Superintendent of Schools; and generally relating to the organization and
- 5 general authority of the State Department of Education.
- 6 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
- 7 Article Education

- 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 13 Article Education
- 14 2-104.
- 15 (a) The following professional assistants shall be appointed to the
- 16 Department:
- 17 (1) No more than [two] THREE Deputy State Superintendents of
- 18 Schools;
- 19 (2) Any assistant State superintendents and directors authorized by the
- 20 State Board and provided in the State budget; and
- 21 (3) Any other professional assistants and agents authorized by the State
- 22 Board and provided in the State budget.
- 23 (b) (1) From the nominees proposed by the State Superintendent, the State
- 24 Board shall appoint all professional assistants to the Department, who shall be in the
- 25 executive service, management service, or special appointments in the State
- 26 Personnel Management System.

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- 1 (2) With the advice of the State Superintendent, the State Board shall 2 set the qualifications for each professional position.
- 3 (3) The State Superintendent may transfer professional assistants 4 within the Department as necessary.
- 5 (c) (1) All professional assistants, grade 31 and above, shall serve at the 6 pleasure of the State Board and the State Superintendent.
- 7 (2) All other professional assistants shall be removed in accordance with 8 procedures set by the State Board.
- 9 (d) (1) In addition to the other duties specified in this section, each 10 professional assistant to the Department has the duties assigned to him by the State 11 Superintendent.
- 12 (2) The Deputy State Superintendent designated by the State
- 13 Superintendent or by the State Board is the acting State Superintendent when the
- 14 State Superintendent is absent or disabled.
- 15 (3) Assistant State superintendents and directors have charge of the 16 various divisions of the Department.
- 17 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take 18 effect July 1, 2001.
