A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concern	ning
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2 Wicomico County - Refunds of Local Transfer Tax

- 3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Wicomico County Council to refund certain
- 4 transfer tax assessed and collected under the authority of certain emergency
- 5 legislation that was subsequently rejected by voters in a referendum; and
- 6 generally relating to authorization for the Wicomico County Council to refund
- 7 certain local transfer tax assessed and collected in Wicomico County.

8 Preamble

- 9 WHEREAS, In 1992 the General Assembly enacted Chapter 399, authorizing
- 10 the Wicomico County Council to impose a local transfer tax; and
- WHEREAS, On May 31, 2000, under the authority granted under Chapter 399
- 12 of the Acts of 1992, the Wicomico County Council passed Wicomico County Council
- 13 Bill No. 2000-5 as an emergency measure effective from the date of its passage,
- 14 imposing a 1% local transfer tax; and
- WHEREAS, The bill enacting the transfer tax was petitioned to referendum
- 16 under the Wicomico County Charter and was rejected by the voters of Wicomico
- 17 County at the election held November 7, 2000; and
- WHEREAS, Because the ordinance imposing the transfer tax had been enacted
- 19 as an emergency measure, the transfer tax remained in effect from the date of its
- 20 enactment until 30 days after the election; and
- 21 WHEREAS, If the ordinance had not been enacted as an emergency measure a
- 22 valid referendum petition would have delayed the effectiveness of the tax until
- 23 approval of the measure by the voters of Wicomico County; and
- 24 WHEREAS, The Wicomico County Council feels that to reflect the voters'
- 25 rejection of the tax in the November 7, 2000 referendum, it has a moral obligation to
- 26 return to taxpayers the tax revenue collected during the very limited period when the
- 27 transfer tax was in effect; and

- WHEREAS, The General Assembly desires to provide the County Council the
- 2 authority to serve the public purpose of refunding those amounts that were collected
- 3 under the local transfer tax while it was briefly in effect, consistent with the voters'
- 4 rejection of the ordinance authorizing the tax; now, therefore,
- 5 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 6 MARYLAND, That the Wicomico County Council may provide for refunds of the local
- 7 transfer tax that was enacted under Wicomico County Council Bill No. 2000-5, as
- 8 authorized by the General Assembly in Chapter 399 of the Acts of 1992, and was
- 9 assessed and collected during the period from the enactment of the tax on May 31,
- 10 2000 until termination of the tax after the rejection of the ordinance imposing the tax
- 11 by voters in a referendum at a November 7, 2000, election.
- 12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 13 June 1, 2001.
