22 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

6 (A) A COMMUNITY COLLEGE TRANSFER STUDENT GRANT SHALL BE IN THE 7 AMOUNT DETERMINED BY THE ELIGIBLE INSTITUTION BUT NOT EXCEEDING THE 8 LESSER OF:

9 (1) ANNUAL TUITION AND MANDATORY FEES AT THE ELIGIBLE 10 INSTITUTION; OR

11 (2) THE EQUIVALENT ANNUAL TUITION AND MANDATORY FEES AT THE 12 UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND, COLLEGE PARK.

13 (B) A COMMUNITY COLLEGE TRANSFER STUDENT GRANT MAY BE USED FOR 14 TUITION AND MANDATORY FEES AT AN ELIGIBLE INSTITUTION.

15 (C) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF THIS TITLE, A
16 COMMUNITY COLLEGE TRANSFER STUDENT GRANT IS IN ADDITION TO ANY OTHER
17 STATE AWARD THAT IS AVAILABLE TO THE STUDENT UNDER THIS TITLE, UP TO A
18 TOTAL STATE AWARD NOT EXCEEDING TUITION AND MANDATORY FEES AT THE
19 ELIGIBLE INSTITUTION.
