SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION

1 A Senate Joint Resolution concerning

2 **State Highways - Vietnam Veterans Highway**

3 FOR the purpose of dedicating a portion of Maryland Route 157 to Vietnam Veterans;  
4 and requesting the State Highway Administration to take all necessary steps to  
5 place a sign or other appropriate monument declaring that Maryland Route 157  
6 is dedicated to Vietnam Veterans.

7 WHEREAS, History has been shaped by the brave men and women in the  
8 United States Armed Forces who answered the call to America's highest duty; and

9 WHEREAS, Many Maryland citizens served in the armed forces with honor in  
10 the Vietnam War;

11 WHEREAS, Veterans and their families deserve to know that this State has not  
12 forgotten their outstanding contributions; and

13 WHEREAS, The State of Maryland acknowledges the great sacrifice and service  
14 of all the men and women who served in the armed forces during the Vietnam War;  
15 now, therefore, be it

16 **RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND**, That the  
17 General Assembly of Maryland requests that the portion of Maryland Route 157  
18 known as the Peninsula Expressway be dedicated to the honor and memory of the  
19 men and women who served in the armed forces during the Vietnam War; and be it  
20 further

21 **RESOLVED**, That the General Assembly of Maryland requests that the State  
22 Highway Administration take all necessary steps to erect a suitable sign or other  
23 monument declaring that the portion of Maryland Route 157 known as the Peninsula  
24 Expressway is dedicated to the honor and memory of the men and women who served  
25 in the armed forces during the Vietnam War; and be it further

26 **RESOLVED**, That a copy of this Resolution be forwarded by the Department of  
27 Legislative Services to the Honorable Parris N. Glendening, Governor of Maryland;
