**Calvert County - Public Local Laws - Budget Amendments**

---

This bill increases from \$50,000 to \$100,000 the total amendment amount to the Calvert County budget to be made only by resolution approved by the Board of County Commissioners of Calvert County after compliance with the publication and hearing requirements.

The bill is effective July 1, 2001.

**Fiscal Summary**

**State Effect:** None.

**Local Effect:** Calvert County expenditures could decrease by a minimal amount due to reduced public hearing costs.

**Small Business Effect:** None.

**Analysis**

**Current Law:** Any amendment to the Calvert County budget totaling more than \$50,000 may be made only by resolution approved by the Board of County Commissioners of Calvert County after compliance with the publication and hearing requirements applicable to the original proposed budget.

**Background:** In the last two fiscal years, Calvert County has had 12 budget amendments, of which six have been for adjustments greater than \$100,000.
