Commerce and Government Matters

Carroll County - County Commissioners - Land Development

This bill requires the County Commissioners of Carroll County to either purchase or remove from the public planning and zoning records a parcel of real property designated for development, including road construction, within three years of making the designation.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: Carroll County finances could be affected by this bill only to the extent that the county purchases property sooner than it would under normal practice.

Analysis

Current Law: The County Commissioners of Carroll County are not required to either purchase or remove from the public planning and zoning records a parcel of real property that has been designated for development within any time period.
