House Bill 1180 Judiciary (Delegate Eckardt, *et al.*)

Dorchester County - Chief Deputy Sheriff and Deputy Sheriffs - Employment Status

This bill establishes that the Chief Deputy Sheriff of Dorchester County serves at the pleasure of the county Sheriff and provides that the Sheriff cannot refuse to reappoint a deputy sheriff without just cause.
