Frederick County - Alcoholic Beverages - Class C (Golf and Country Club) Licenses

This bill authorizes the Board of License Commissioners of Frederick County to issue a special Class C (golf and country club) license in the 16th election district.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: Frederick County revenues could increase by \$1,500 annually for each Class C (golf and country club) license issued. No effect on expenditures.

Small Business Effect: Meaningful positive impact on any club that is issued a special Class C license.

Analysis

Current Law: The Board of License Commissioners of Frederick County may not issue a license for the sale of alcoholic beverages to any place of business in the 16th election district.

Background: The 16th election district is the town of Myersville.

Local Fiscal Effect: A special Class C (golf and country club) license in Frederick County is \$1,500 annually. The county anticipates one golf and country club to apply

for a special Class C (golf and country club) license in the 16th election district raising revenues by \$1,500 annually.
