Child Abuse - Reports - Public School Contractors and Employees of Contractors

This bill authorizes the disclosure of reports or records concerning child abuse or neglect to public school superintendents for personnel or administrative actions following a report of suspected child abuse committed by an independent contractor or an employee of an independent contractor who supervises or works directly with students.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: This bill would not directly affect governmental operations or finances.

Local Effect: None.

Small Business Effect: None.

Analysis

Current Law: Generally, records and reports concerning child abuse or neglect are confidential, and their unauthorized disclosure is a criminal offense. Such records may be disclosed on request to the appropriate public school superintendent for the purpose of carrying out appropriate personnel actions following a report of suspected child abuse involving a student committed by a public school employee.
