Election Law - State Board of Elections - Internet Website - Candidate and Ballot Question Directory

This bill requires the State Board of Elections to maintain a candidate and ballot question directory on its official Internet website. The directory would include the name, photograph, biography, and an issue(s) statement by every candidate filing a certificate of candidacy with the State board or a local board. A description of each ballot question would also be posted on the site. The State board is required to adopt regulations to implement the bill's provisions.

The bill is effective October 1, 2003.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: \$15,000 general fund expenditure increase for the State Board of Elections in FY 2003 for purchasing hardware and software necessary for an electronic database with graphical interface and online querying capabilities. Maintenance of the system in the out-years could be handled with existing budgeted resources.
