Judiciary

Harford County - State's Attorney - Salary

This bill increases the salary of the State's Attorney of Harford County from \$80,320 to \$85,160 beginning on July 1, 2003. The salary increases to \$90,000 beginning on July 1, 2004 and each year thereafter.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: Harford County expenditures will increase by \$5,700 in FY 2004 and by \$11,400 in FY 2005 and each year thereafter. Revenues would not be affected.

Small Business Effect: None.

Analysis

Current Law: The salary of the State's Attorney of Harford County is set at \$80,230 for fiscal 2003 and each year thereafter. Salary adjustments for constitutional officers take effect at the beginning of the next term of office, which begins in January 2003 for the State's Attorney of Harford County.

Background: The salary of the State's Attorney of Harford County was last changed in 1999 (Chapter 732 of 1998).

Local Fiscal Effect: Harford County expenditures will increase by \$5,677 in fiscal 2004 for additional salary and benefits (17.3%), which accounts for the effective date of July 1,

2003. Harford County expenditures will increase by \$11,355 in fiscal 2005 and each year thereafter.
