## State Personnel - Task Force to Study the Compensation of Promoted and Reclassified State Employees

This bill establishes a seven-member Task Force to Study the Compensation of Promoted and Reclassified State Employees.

The bill takes effect June 1, 2001. The task force's report is to be completed by September 30, 2001, and the bill terminates on that date.

### **Fiscal Summary**

**State Effect:** Any expense reimbursements for the task force members and staffing costs for the Department of Budget and Management are assumed to be minimal and absorbable within existing budgeted resources.

**Background:** The bill requires the task force to study the timing of certain reclassifications and promotions in relation to February 1, 2000, when the maximum allowable increase in annual salary was raised.
