House Bill 262 (Frederick County Delegation)

Ways and Means

Economic and Environmental Affairs

Frederick County - Board of Community College Trustees

This bill increases from two to three the maximum number of consecutive terms that a member of the Board of Community College Trustees for Frederick County may serve.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: None. Allowing for more extended service to the Board of Community College Trustees for Frederick County would not affect county finances.

Small Business Effect: None.

Analysis

Current Law: A member of the Board of Community College Trustees for Frederick County may not serve more than two consecutive five-year terms. The board consists of seven members appointed by the Governor. Members must be residents of Frederick County and may not be members of the Frederick County Board of Education.
