House Bill 372 Ways and Means

**Budget and Taxation** 

#### Garrett County - Property Tax Credit - Garrett County, Maryland, Community Action Committee, Inc.

This bill authorizes Garrett County to grant a county property tax credit for property owned by the Garrett County, Maryland, Community Action Committee, Inc. or by an entity in which the action committee has a controlling interest.

The bill is effective June 30, 2001 and applicable to tax years after June 30, 2001.

#### **Fiscal Summary**

State Effect: None. The bill does not grant a State property tax credit.

**Local Effect:** Garrett County property tax revenues could decrease by approximately \$62,800 annually.

**Small Business Effect:** Minimal for one nonprofit entity. The Garrett County, Maryland, Community Action Committee, Inc.'s property taxes could decrease by \$62,800 annually.

#### Analysis

**Local Revenues:** Garrett County property tax revenues could decrease by approximately \$62,800 annually, based on the assumption that the county would grant a 100% property tax credit. Real property currently owned by the Garrett County, Maryland, Community Action Committee, Inc. is valued at \$5,061,762. Additionally, the committee is

constructing a building that is estimated to have a value of \$1 million. Garrett County's current property tax rate is \$1.036 per \$100 of assessed value.
