**Prince George's County - Alcoholic Beverages - License Transfers**  
**PG 302-01**

---

This bill specifies that a transfer of an alcoholic beverages license in Prince George's County includes a change in the ownership of more than the cumulative amount of 50% of the stock in an establishment since a new license was issued or the establishment was granted an existing license by transfer.

---

**Fiscal Summary**

**State Effect:** None.

**Local Effect:** Prince George's County finances would not be directly affected.

**Small Business Effect:** Minimal.

---

**Analysis**

**Current Law:** Except where prohibited, a change in ownership requires a license transfer to the new owners. Alcoholic beverage licenses in Prince George's County with off-sale privileges of any class may not be transferred to chain stores, supermarkets, or discount houses.
