Senate Joint Resolution 2 (Senator Stone)

Finance

State Highways - Vietnam Veterans Highway

This joint resolution requests that the State Highway Administration (SHA) designate the portion of Maryland Route 157 known as the Peninsula Expressway as the Vietnam Veterans' Highway and calls for a sign or monument to dedicate the roadway to the Maryland citizens who served in the Vietnam War.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: Transportation Trust Fund expenditures would increase by \$500 to \$1,000 for each sign that needs to be erected; two or more signs may be necessary. Expenditures could increase by as much as \$10,000 to construct a monument.

Local Effect: None.

Small Business Effect: None.

Analysis

Current Law: The portion of the Maryland Route 24 between the U. S. Route 1 Bypass and U. S. Route 40 is designated as the Vietnam Veterans' Memorial Highway. No State road is currently named the Vietnam Veterans' Highway.
