### **FISCAL NOTE**

House Bill 173 Judiciary (Delegate Montague, et al.)

#### **Abandoned Infants**

This bill defines an "abandoned infant" as being an infant not more than one year old who appears to have been deserted by the child's natural parents or legal guardian. A court may find that a child is an abandoned infant if no one has claimed to be the child's natural parent within 30 days of the abandonment.

## Analysis

**Current Law:** A parent currently has two months to reclaim a child, regardless of age, before the child is declared to have been abandoned.
