Commerce and Government Matters

Election Law - Campaign Financing - Contribution and Transfer Limits

This bill raises the individual contribution limit to a candidate or political committee to \$6,000 and raises the total contribution limit to \$15,000. It also increases the limit on transfers between political committees to \$9,000.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: \$10,000 one-time increase in general fund expenditures for the State Board of Elections in FY 2002 for software retooling. No effect on revenues.

Analysis

Current Law: The individual contribution limit is \$4,000, with an overall \$10,000 limit on contributions for the four-year election cycle. There is a \$6,000 limit on transfers between political committees.

Prior Introductions: A similar bill, HB 76 was introduced in the 2000 session. It received an unfavorable report from the House Commerce and Government Matters Committee.
