Senate Bill 273(Senator Stoltzfus, et al.)Economic and Environmental Affairs

Recreational Fishery - Croakers - Increase in Maximum Daily Catch

This bill increases the maximum daily recreational catch for croakers from 25 to 50 fish per day.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: The bill would not materially affect State operations or finances.

Local Effect: None.

Small Business Effect: Potential meaningful. By increasing the maximum daily catch from 25 to 50 fish per day, the bill could cause an increase in demand for charter boat services as well as other small businesses involved in the recreational fishing industry such as bait and tackle shops.

Analysis

Current Law: Chapter 577 of 1997 increased the maximum daily recreational catch for croakers from 20 to 25 fish per day.
