Carroll County - Sheriff's Salary

This bill increases the salary of the Sheriff of Carroll County from \$45,000 to \$50,000 beginning with the next term of office in December 2002. The salary increases to \$55,000 in December 2003, to \$60,000 in December 2004, and to \$65,000 in December 2005 and each year thereafter.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: Carroll County expenditures would increase by \$3,900 in FY 2003 and \$24,200 by fiscal 2006. Revenues would not be affected.

Small Business Effect: None.

Analysis

Current Law: The Sheriff of Carroll County earns an annual salary of \$45,000. Salary adjustments for constitutional officers take effect at the beginning of the next term of office, which begins December 2002 for the Sheriff of Carroll County.

Background: The salary for the Sheriff of Carroll County was last changed in 1999 (Chapter 111 of 1998), when it was increased from \$37,500 to \$45,000.

Local Fiscal Effect: Carroll County expenditures would increase by \$3,938 in fiscal 2003 for additional salary and fringe benefits (35%), which accounts for the beginning of

the next term in December 2002. Carroll County expenditures will increase by \$10,688 in fiscal 2004, and by \$17,438 in fiscal 2005, and by \$24,188 in fiscal 2006 and each year thereafter.
