State Highways - Dedication - Vietnam Veterans Highway

---

This bill requires the State Highway Administration (SHA) and the Maryland Transportation Commission to dedicate the portion of Maryland Route 157 known as the Peninsula Expressway as the Vietnam Veterans Highway.

Fiscal Summary

**State Effect:** Minimal. Transportation Trust Fund expenditures would increase by \$500 to \$1,000 for each sign that needs to be erected; two or more signs may be necessary. Revenues would not be affected.

**Local Effect:** None.

**Small Business Effect:** None.

Analysis

**Current Law:** The portion of Maryland Route 24 between the U.S. Route 1 Bypass and U.S. Route 40 is designated as the Vietnam Veterans Memorial Highway. No State road is currently named the Vietnam Veterans' Highway.

The Maryland Transportation Commission is responsible for studying the State transportation system and advising the Secretary of Transportation and department administrators on transportation policy and programs.
