Frederick County - Citizens Nursing Home Board - Selection of Members

This bill alters the method of appointing members to the Frederick County Citizens Nursing Home Board by requiring board members to be appointed by the county commissioners.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: Altering the method of appointing members to the Citizens Nursing Home Board would not affect Frederick County finances.

Small Business Effect: None.

Analysis

Current Law: A majority or quorum of the members of the Frederick County Citizens Nursing Home Board elect successors to the board for terms of three years when terms expire or for the remainder of the term when vacancies occur.

Background: Frederick County advises these procedures are current practice. The Frederick County Citizens Nursing Home Board has ten members serving staggered terms of three years. The board was created in 1976.
