House Bill 634 (Frederick County Delegation)

Budget and Taxation

Frederick County - Funds Designated for County Roads

This bill authorizes the Board of County Commissioners of Frederick County to use federal or State funds designated for county road purposes for either county road purposes or public easement roads. The bill also repeals the provision requiring all federal, State, or county funds designated for county road purposes to be used only for county roads.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: This bill changes how State and federal funds for county roads can be used and would not affect Frederick County finances.

Small Business Effect: None.

Analysis

Current Law: All federal, State, or county funds designated for county road purposes in Frederick County must be used only for county road purposes including the payment of all salaries and expenses incidental to the operation of the county roads board. All disbursements from such funds must be upon written order of the board of county commissioners.
