Land Reclamation Committee - Members - Statement of Employment and
Financial Interests

This bill requires members of the Land Reclamation Committee to file a U.S. Department of the Interior State Employee Statement of Employment and Financial Interests.

The bill takes effect July 1, 2001.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None. The bill would not directly affect governmental finances.

Analysis

Current Law: The Land Reclamation Committee consists of 13 members. Committee members must recuse themselves from proceedings that may affect their direct or indirect financial interests.

Additional Information

Prior Introductions: Identical legislation was introduced during the 1999 session as SB 59. The bill passed the Senate but received an unfavorable report by the House Environmental Matters Committee.
