House Bill 455 (Allegany County Delegation)

Judicial Proceedings

Western Maryland - Local Correctional Facility Officials - Appointment by Code Home Rule Counties

This bill authorizes the board of county commissioners in a county in Western Maryland that has adopted code home rule to provide for the appointment of a managing official and necessary assistants for the local correctional facility.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None. The bill would not directly affect governmental operations or finances.

Local Effect: None. Changing the appointment process for existing employees would not affect Allegany County finances.

Small Business Effect: None.

Analysis

Current Law: The specific authority for boards of county commissioners granted under this bill does not now exist. Allegany County is the only code home rule county in Western Maryland.
