Ethics Law - Purchases by Legislators From Lobbyists

This bill requires the Joint Ethics Committee to develop rules that require members of the General Assembly to report the purchase from a regulated lobbyist of a sports ticket, meal, or other item that if received by the member absent a purchase would be a prohibited gift.
