Highways - Dedication - Veterans of Foreign Wars Memorial Highway

This bill requires the State Highway Administration to dedicate the portion of Interstate Highway 83 from the Interstate Highway 695 intersection to the Maryland-Pennsylvania border as the Veterans of Foreign Wars Memorial Highway.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: Transportation Trust Fund expenditures would increase by \$500 to \$1,000 for each new highway sign; two or more signs may be necessary. If a monument is necessary, expenditures would increase by approximately \$10,000.
