Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission - Prince George's County - Subdivision Appeal MC/PG 129-01

This bill requires that an appeal of a final action on a subdivision application by the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission in Prince George's County be filed in accordance with subdivision regulations. The bill applies only if the subdivision regulations provide for an appeal to the Prince George's County Council sitting as the district council.

Local Effect: Potential minimal increase in administrative costs related to hearings by the Prince George's County Council sitting as the district council.

Current Law: The Prince George's County Council, serving as the district council, adopts subdivision regulations within Prince George's County. Appeals are currently filed in the circuit court.
