Elections - Campaign Finance Reports - Periods Covered by Reports

This bill alters the periods covered for information contained on a statement of contributions and expenditures filed by a candidate under the State election code. The bill requires a candidate filing a statement containing contribution and expenditure activity to include all such activity up to and including ten days before the report filing deadline. It also requires a pre-election statement to be filed disclosing activity up to and including the second Tuesday before an election.

Analysis

Current Law: Currently a candidate must include activities up to the seventh day before all report filing deadlines and pre-election statements must disclose activity up to the Sunday before an election.
