Taxation - Constitutional Amendment

This joint resolution memorializes the U. S. Congress to propose and submit to the several states for ratification no later than January 1, 2002 an amendment to the U. S. Constitution providing that no federal court shall have the power to order a state or local government to levy or increase taxes. The joint resolution also calls upon the members of the Maryland Congressional Delegation to utilize their resources and influence to ensure passage of such an amendment to the U. S. Constitution.

State Effect: Compliance with this joint resolution would not materially alter State operations or finances.
