### Frederick County - Lamar Sanitarium Historic Museum Loan of 1999

This bill allows the Board of Directors of the Central Maryland Heritage League, Inc., as grantee, to use funds expended prior to June 1, 1999 to meet the required match for the Frederick County-Lamar Sanitarium Historic Museum Loan of 1999.

# **Fiscal Summary**

**State Effect:** None. Allowing prior expended funds would not directly affect State finances.

Local Effect: None.

**Small Business Effect:** Minimal impact on one small nonprofit entity.

# **Analysis**

**Current Law:** Chapter 225 of 1999 authorized up to \$100,000 in matching funds to the grantee for the acquisition, repair, and renovation of a historic building known as Dr. Lamar's Sanitarium, a facility designated as a historic landmark and formerly used for the medical and surgical treatment of patients, to be used as a historical museum with associated offices.

**Background:** The Central Maryland Heritage League, Inc. is a nonprofit corporation formed to organize and operate as an association exclusively for charitable, educational, and civic purposes.

The grantee already expended funds exceeding \$100,000 prior to June 1, 1999.
