Task Force to Study Dispute Resolution Concerning Access to Public Records

This joint resolution establishes an 11-member Task Force to Study Dispute Resolution Concerning Access to Public Records. The task force is charged with studying alternative means of resolving disputes concerning access to public records, including cost and feasibility considerations, and is required to report its findings by December 31, 2001. The Department of Legislative Services must provide staff support for the task force.
