#### **Baltimore City - Alcoholic Beverages - Restrictions on Hours of Sale**

This bill authorizes the Baltimore City Board of License Commissioners to restrict by regulation the hours for sale of alcoholic beverages by any licensee on any day between 6:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m.

## **Fiscal Summary**

State Effect: None.

**Local Effect:** The Baltimore City Board of License Commissioners could adopt regulations and monitor licensees with existing resources.

Small Business Effect: Minimal.

### **Analysis**

**Current Law:** Baltimore City licensees may sell alcoholic beverages at all hours except between 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m.

**Small Business Effect:** Small alcoholic beverages retailers may have their hours further restricted, but any impact due to lost revenues between 6:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m. is expected to be minimal.

**Prior Introductions:** The same legislation was introduced in 2000 as SB 547 and was withdrawn before the hearing.
