Maryland Veterans Commission - Membership - World War II Veteran

This bill requires the State at-large member of the Maryland Veterans Commission to be a veteran of World War II.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: Requiring the State at-large member of the Maryland Veterans Commission to be a World War II veteran would not materially affect State finances.

Local Effect: None.

Small Business Effect: None.

Analysis

Current Law: The Maryland Veterans Commission is comprised of 29 members, including one member appointed from the State at-large.

Background: The Maryland Veterans Commission serves Maryland veterans and their dependents through the Veterans Service Program, which is conducted through veterans service centers across the State. According to 1998 Census statistics, there are 113,000 veterans of World War II living in Maryland.
