State Highways - Designation - Korean War Veterans Memorial Highway

This bill requires the State Highway Administration (SHA) to designate Maryland Route 43 as the Korean War Veterans Memorial Highway.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: Minimal. Transportation Trust Fund expenditures would increase by \$500 to \$1,000 for each sign that needs to be erected; two or more signs may be necessary. Revenues would not be affected.

Local Effect: None.

Small Business Effect: None.

Current Law: None applicable.

Prior Introductions: An identical bill was introduced as HB 1382 in the 2000 session, but was not reported from the House Rules and Executive Nominations Committee.
