AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 300

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike “Delegate Conroy” and substitute “Delegates Conroy, DeCarlo, Hixson, Healey, Bartlett, Bohanan, Bozman, Carlson, Cryor, C. Davis, Finifter, Howard, Marriott, McKee, Patterson, Phillips, Ports, Rosso, Rudolph, Rzepkowski, Shriver, Zirkin, Cadden, Leopold, Owings, Love, Sophocleus, Boschert, Clagett, Baldwin, W. Baker, Greenip, Boutin, Brinkley, Cane, Elliott, Hecht, Giannetti, Heller, Hutchins, Hubbard, James, McClenahan, Minnick, Mohorovic, Montague, Riley, Stocksdales, Vallario, Wood, Mandel, Hurson, Walkup, and Klausmeier”; in line 6, strike “acts of terrorism” and substitute “terrorist attacks; establishing a certain limit on the amount of the Edward T. Conroy Memorial Scholarship that may be awarded to a child or spouse of a victim of certain terrorist attacks; defining a certain term”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, strike in their entirety lines 18 through 25, inclusive.

On page 2, in lines 1, 9, and 10, in each instance, strike the brackets; in lines 1, 9, and 10, strike “(3)”, “(4)”, and “(5)”, respectively; and in line 19, strike “(6)” and substitute “(5)”.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 3, in line 22, after “ATTACKS” insert a period; and strike in its entirety line 23.

AMENDMENT NO. 4

On page 4, after line 4, insert:

“(3) AN AWARD PROVIDED UNDER SUBSECTION (D)(8) OF THIS SECTION MAY NOT EXCEED THE AMOUNT SPECIFIED IN SUBSECTION (E)(2) OF THIS SECTION WHEN COMBINED WITH ANY OTHER SCHOLARSHIP RECEIVED BY A STUDENT BASED ON THE STUDENT’S STATUS AS A CHILD OR SPOUSE OF A VICTIM OF THE SEPTEMBER 11, 2001 TERRORIST ATTACKS.”.
