AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 350, AS AMENDED

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

In the Environmental Matters Committee Amendments (HB0350/760819/1), in Amendment No. 1, strike beginning with “authorizing” in line 3 down through “effect” in line 5 and substitute “prohibiting the State primary drinking water regulations from being less stringent than certain national drinking water regulations in effect during a certain period”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

In the Environmental Matters Committee Amendments, strike Amendment No. 2 in its entirety.

On page 1 of the bill, in line 19, after “(b)” insert “(1)”; in the same line, strike the bracket; in lines 20 and 22, strike “(1)” and “(2)”, respectively, and substitute “(I)” and “(II)”, respectively; in line 22, strike “] NOT REQUIRE”; and after line 23, insert:

“(2) NOTWITHSTANDING PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE STATE PRIMARY DRINKING WATER REGULATIONS MAY NOT BE LESS STRINGENT THAN THE COMPLETE INTERIM OR REVISED NATIONAL PRIMARY DRINKING WATER REGULATIONS IN EFFECT IN JANUARY 2002.”.
