AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 641

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, strike beginning with “a” in line 5 down through “agencies” in line 6 and substitute “certain circumstances; requiring the Sheriff or Sheriff’s deputy to notify certain law enforcement agencies within a certain time that an investigation has commenced; requiring the Sheriff or Sheriff’s deputy to transfer an investigation under certain circumstances”; and after line 13 insert:

“BY adding to

Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings  
Section 2-309(r)(10)  
Annotated Code of Maryland  
(1998 Replacement Volume and 2001 Supplement)”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, strike beginning with “ANY” in line 10 down through “MATTER” in line 12 and substitute “INVESTIGATIONS ARISING OUT OF OR INCIDENT TO NORMALLY ASSIGNED DUTIES.

(10) WHEN A SHERIFF OR SHERIFF’S DEPUTY HAS COMMENCED AN INVESTIGATION UNDER PARAGRAPH (9)(IV) OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE SHERIFF OR THE SHERIFF’S DESIGNEE:

(I) SHALL IMMEDIATELY NOTIFY THE APPROPRIATE LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY THAT HAS JURISDICTION OVER THE MATTER; AND

(II) SHALL TRANSFER THE INVESTIGATION TO AN APPROPRIATE LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY THAT HAS JURISDICTION OVER THE MATTER ON REQUEST OF THE AGENCY”.
