AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 801

(Third Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 2, strike “Christopher’s Law II - Repeat Child Sexual Offenses” and substitute “Crimes - First Degree Rape and Sexual Offense - Subsequent Offenders”; in line 6, strike “involving a child under a certain age”; strike beginning with “involving” in line 7 down through “parole” in line 9 and substitute “under certain circumstances”; in line 10, strike “child”; and in line 14, strike “through 3-306” and substitute “and 3-305”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in line 21, strike “UPON” and substitute “ON”; and strike beginning with “3-304” in line 27 down through “YEARS” in line 29 and substitute “§ 3-305 OF THIS SUBTITLE”.

On pages 2 and 3, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 33 on page 2 down through line 23 on page 3, inclusive.

On page 4, in line 8, strike “UPON” and substitute “ON”; and strike beginning with “§ 3-304,” in line 14 down through “YEARS” in line 16 and substitute “OF THIS SUBTITLE”.

On pages 4 and 5, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 20 on page 4 through line 9 on page 5, inclusive.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 5, strike in their entirety lines 10 through 13, inclusive, and substitute:

“SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be construed to apply to subsequent offenses committed on or after the effective date of this Act:

- (1) regardless of whether the previous conviction was for an offense committed

(Over)

before, on, or after the effective date of this Act; and

(2) if the subsequent offense was committed after the date of conviction for the prior offense.”
