AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 342

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 6, after “Development” insert “regarding the granting of formal recognition of Maryland Indian status to a certain tribe, band, group, or clan”; strike beginning with “propose” in line 8 down through “for” in line 10 and substitute “accept or reject the recommendations made by the Commission on Indian Affairs within a certain period of time; prohibiting”; in line 10, strike “to” and substitute “of”; in line 11, strike “without” and substitute “unless”; in the same line, strike “proposing” and substitute “proposes”; and in the same line, after “order” insert “granting formal recognition”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in lines 33 and 34, strike “SHALL FORMALLY RECOGNIZE” and substitute “SHALL:”

(I) GRANT FORMAL RECOGNITION OF MARYLAND INDIAN STATUS”;

in line 34, after “ORDER,” insert “TO”; in line 35, after “clan” insert “AS RECOMMENDED BY THE COMMISSION; OR”

(II) REJECT THE COMMISSION’S RECOMMENDATION”;

and in line 36, strike “promulgated” and substitute “ISSUED”.

On page 3, in line 1, after “GOVERNOR” insert “REJECTS THE COMMISSION’S RECOMMENDATION, AND”; in line 3, strike “SHALL RECEIVE” and substitute “MAY NOT BE GRANTED”; in line 4, strike “WITHOUT AN EXECUTIVE ORDER” and substitute “OF MARYLAND INDIAN STATUS UNLESS A SUBSEQUENT APPLICATION IS SUBMITTED”

(Over)

AND APPROVED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS SECTION"; and strike in their entirety lines 14 through 18, inclusive.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 3, in line 33, after "That" insert ":

(1)";

in line 35, after "Commission" insert "on Indian Affairs"; in line 36, after "recognition" insert "of Maryland Indian status"; and in line 37, after "2002" insert "; and

(2) the Governor shall have 120 days from the effective date of this Act to comply with Article 83B, § 5-406(d) of the Code, as enacted by this Act, with respect to an application described under item (1) of this section".
